Braemar Charitable Trust is the 100% owner of Braemar Hospital, one of New Zealand's largest private hospitals.

The Trust's vision is to advance healthcare equity and access through the ownership of the hospital, facilitating free community surgeries and other health interventions, collaborating for better health outcomes, growing the medical workforce and their knowledge and skills, and contributing to medical research.

Hospital ownership

- The Trust fully owns Braemar Hospital which is a major pillar in its strategy for improving health outcomes.
- A portion of all Hospital fees are paid to the Trust via dividends so the Trust can undertake its charitable activities.

Community Surgery Programme

- Free surgery/procedures for those who meet the criteria, have no insurance or ACC funding, nor the financial means to pay, and have been declined or have little chance of having their procedure in the public system in a timely manner.
- Enabled through the generous support of credentialed specialists at Braemar Hospital who donate their time. Braemar Hospital supplies consumables at cost, Braemar Charitable Trust covers other costs.

Partnerships

The Trust collaborates with healthcare and community providers to enable improved health outcomes in communities where there is unmet and unseen need.

Contributing to medical research

Helping fund research that enhances medical knowledge and supports the Trust's vision for better health outcomes.
